Hair by 'Starsky & Hutch' and rockboots à la Eric's Café, Tremadog

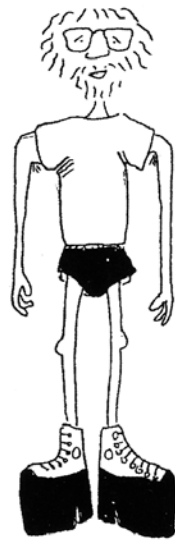


Angry young Ken has the new Chequed and Itchy range. by 'Bumble Fashions' Shirt 4s 6d Breeches 1/6 4b

Gritstone Guru Jon is wearing the latest warmwear by 'Afghan' - Oxfam 75p



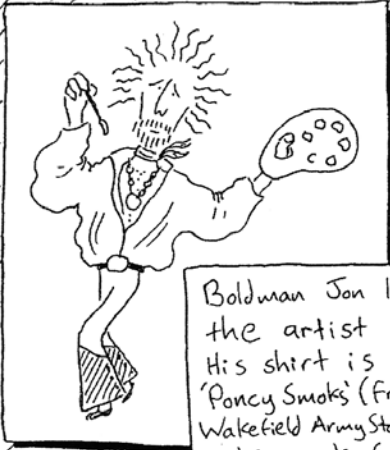
Jon's sidekick Steve has a pair of the latest wide style leggings made from the finest gunge ridden, threadbare denim from the Skip at the end of the road.
