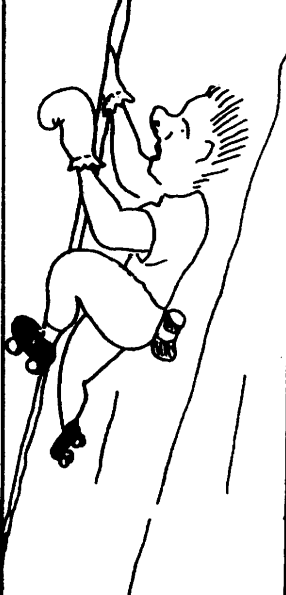
They're OK. They've got some good bits. He's look here's one now

A light breakfast is usually followed by some conservation work. Today it is tree planting at Malham



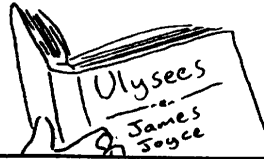
Later I drove across to the gritstone to climb The New Statesman wearing my usual hideously ugly mask

If there's no gear, why has he got a rope on?



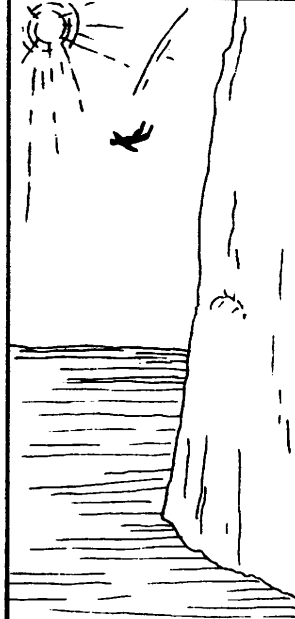
The Secret Diary of John Dunne (continued)

On my way back I polished off a new 8c+ at El Chorro which none of the Spanish can do.



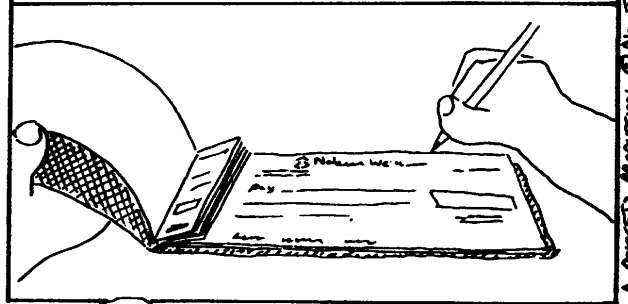
When I got back home, Mum had my tea ready
